















# FINSA-Compact – Code of Conduct

#### For FINSA-compliant client advice!

Article 6 of the Federal Act on Financial Services FinSA requires that client advisers must possess professional expertise and knowledge of the code of conduct to offer financial instruments and render financial services. For employees of FINMA-supervised financial institutions, e.g. banks and insurance companies, as well as independent asset managers, the responsibility lies with the employer, according to FinIA. Employees of other institutions and self-employed financial service providers must get themselves listed in a FINMA-approved register of advisers.

#### Who must register in one of the advisor registers under the FINSA?



The online course FinSA-Compact – Proof of Knowledge: Code of Conduct certifies that the candidate possesses the necessary knowledge of the code of conduct and is recognised by register of advisers Regservices.ch as proof of training. Regservices.ch is a FINMA-licensed register of advisers as stipulated by FinSA.

This online course is aimed at consultants who only need proof of knowledge of the code of conduct. These consultants will already possess proof of knowledge for the necessary professional expertise e.g. from an earlier training or continuing education programme.

We recommend that consultants seeking proof of professional expertise should qualify as certified asset managers by completing the IAF training course which fulfils statutory requirements.
